Message from Headteacher

Happy New Year to our families. I hope that you had a restful and enjoyable Christmas break and send sincere best wishes for 2023. On behalf of every member of the team, may I again say thank you for the cards and gifts we received prior the Christmas break. Thank you for your kindness and generosity. We start the new year full of enthusiasm, ready to drive ahead with several exciting initiatives and activities.

- · Clubs start again from next Monday. In addition to the array of sporting and arts activities on offer, we have added new clubs including Shakespeare Club where children will work towards a performance of Romeo & Juliet. In response to parental feedback, we have expanded numbers permitted in popular clubs.
- · Work is underway towards the Learning Outside the Classroom award with Mrs Jones leading our drive to achieve this. Mrs Salisbury, Miss Hildebrandt and Mr Underhill are also exploring the NACE Challenge Award which recognises strong practice in supporting more able pupils.
- · We have several interesting trips and visitors lined up with Year five preparing to encounter a Viking and Year 4 enjoying a visit to local museums to explore the Roman history.
- · There is already an array of sports fixtures in the diary hopefully we can replicate the success we enjoyed in the autumn term.
- · We plan to extend our community partnerships building on the strong links we have local organisations and residential care homes. During the INSET day on Tuesday 3rd January, our subject leaders met with their counterparts from other local schools in our cluster group at Upton High School to discuss ways in which we can work collaboratively to enrich opportunities for pupils in our local area.
- · Later this term, we will begin to prepare for the transition of new pupils joining Reception in September 2023 working in partnership with HETTY and other local nurseries to ensure that children are well prepared to start school. We currently have eighty-five applications for places at our school in September 2023 our popularity is certainly growing! As we attained the Early Years Quality Mark in Summer 2022 based on the quality of provision, the curriculum and support for early learners in Reception, we are very well placed to increase our support for other settings in ensuring that children have the very best start to their educational journey.

Safety Alert


