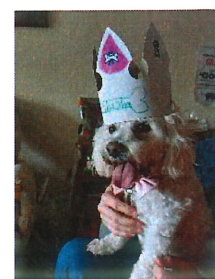

# HOW TO CARE FOR HORSES by Madison & Azra



Provide adequate nutrition for your horse through grass, hay, chaff and supplements.

Provide your horse with fresh water.

Cater to your horse's unique needs.

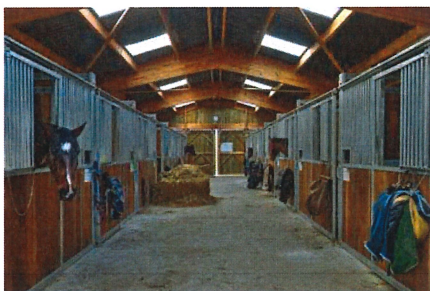
Make sure that your horse gets adequate exercise through riding, training and interaction.

Keep track of and schedule routine horse care procedures like hoof trimmings, teeth floating, deworming and vaccinations.

## FACTS ABOUT HORSES.

Horses have better senses of smell and hearing than humans do. Their ears can turn in different directions to aid their hearing. As well as that, they can use their eyes and nostrils to express their moods.

It is extremely unlikely to see horses in a herd lying down simultaneously. This is because at least one horse will stand and keep a lookout in order to be able to alert the others of any potential dangers.



They get scared by anything as kicking out is the way of defending themselves. It is extremely dangerous to stand behind a horse, as they are liable to kick out if they get scared.

Horses have a different range of different neighs to communicate. Whinnying and neighing sounds are made when horses meet or leave each other. Stallions (adult male horses) perform loud roars as meeting calls, and all horses will use snorts to alert others of potential danger. Mares (adult female horses) use deep smooth sounds, whickering, when they are nursing a foal (infant horse).

## Manchester United by Atharva (No. 1 Fan!)

**Since 1992, we have won the Premier League 13 times. In total, we have won a record 20 English League titles, a record 12 FA Cups, 4 League Cups, 3 European Champions Cups and 1 FIFA Club World Cup, making us one of the most successful clubs in England.**

**Manchester United was the first English club to win the European Championship in 1968. In 1999, they became the first English club to win a Treble. They earned Premier League championships, FA Cup winners, and Champions League.**

**No one has won more Premier League titles than Manchester United. Red Devils have won 13 times out of the 28 seasons played so far. But Manchester also leads the tournament's historical table in terms of most wins, most goals, and most points won.**

**In 2011, Manchester United was followed by more than one-tenth of the world. They also won the Carabao Cup.**

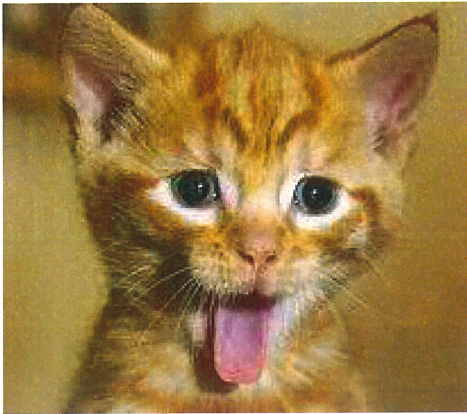
You can also use a relative clause at the end of a sentence.

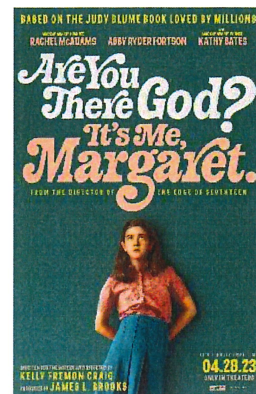

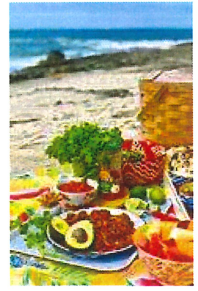



# Greek Gods

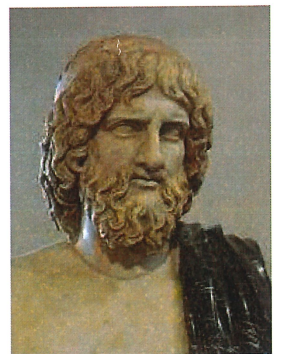
## *Poseidon: Lord of The Oceans*

He was responsible for punishing the dead and he made sure no one left through the gates. The Lord of the Underworld was a creative torture maker. For example: Sisyphus had to roll a colossal boulder up a steep hill but every time, it rolled back down onto him.



## *Hera: Queen of the Gods*

Hera was the oldest child of Kronos and Rhea. She was the goddess of family and mothership and was married to her younger brother Zeus who was not a loyal husband. Hera was very jealous of the other women Zeus loved so she always punished them. For example: she turned the river nymph Io into a cow and sent a fly to bite her eternally.



## *Demeter: Goddess of the Harvest*

Demeter was responsible for making sure that the plants and crops grew every year. She preferred to live on Earth with her daughter, Persephone, than to live on Olympus with the other gods, including Zeus, Persephone's father. ## *Hestia: Goddess of the Hearth*

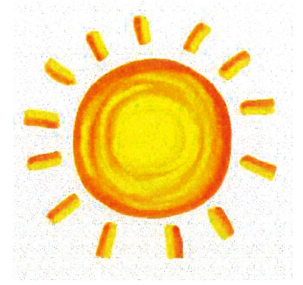

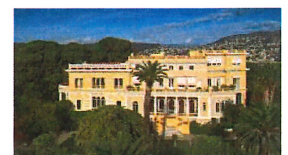

She paid a visit to her local hairdresser after growing her hair with no haircuts for ages in order to have her long golden locks cut on behalf of the Little Princess Trust.



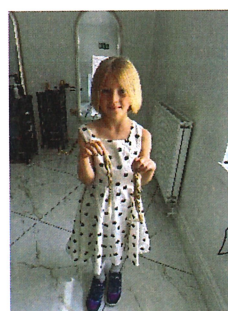
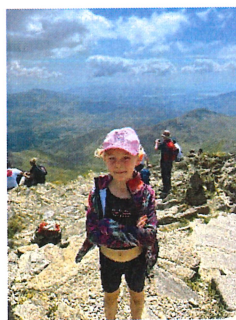

To date the Justgiving page has raised a phenomenal amount of £672!

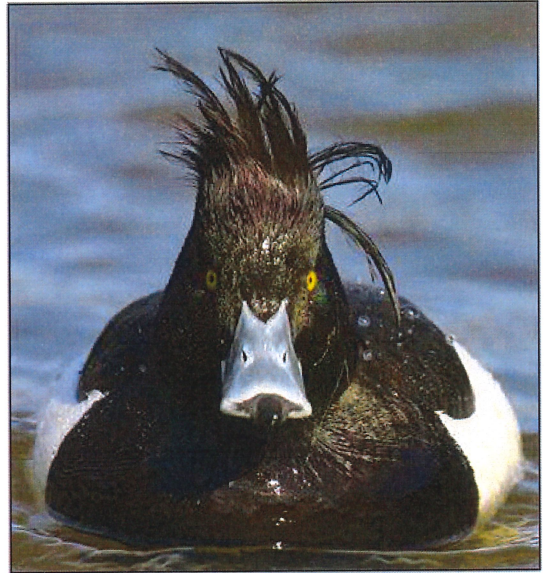

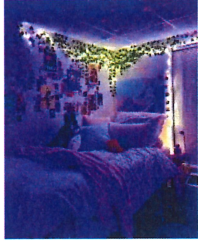

# *Spring chicken*

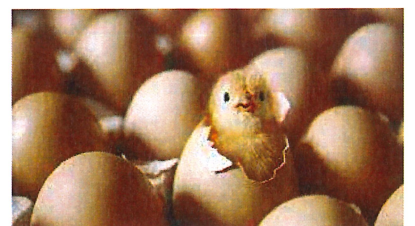


Wow! How time has passed. It felt like just yesterday when I cracked out of the egg. OH! Sorry. Rewind.

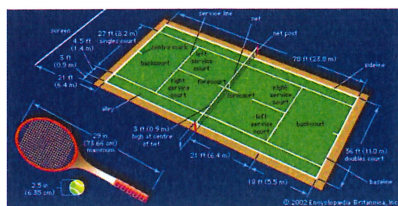

# TENNIS BY MIKEY



Tennis is a fast sport for two or four players. It can be played either outdoors or indoors. Tennis players use a stringed racket to hit a ball over a net. They score points by hitting the ball out of the other players reach.

Tennis is played on a rectangular court. The court is 23.8 metres long. The width depends on if there are two or four players. For a singles match (two players), the court is 8.2 metres wide. For a doubles match (four players), the court is 11 metres wide. The surface of the court may be grass, clay, or a hard material such as concrete. The court is divided in half by a net that is 0.9 metres high.

**Equipment** - The only equipment needed for tennis is a racket and a ball. A tennis racket has a frame with crossed strings attached to it. Most racket frames are made of a lightweight material such as graphite. Tennis balls are small, light, and bouncy. They are usually yellow or white.

**Rules** - A tennis game begins with a serve. One of the players, called the server, stands at one end of the court. The server throws the ball into the air and tries to hit it over the net. The opponent (other player) tries to return the serve—hit the ball back over the net. The players hit the ball back and forth until one of them fails to make a good return. Then the other player scores a point. The players try to hit the ball to a part of the court where the opponent will have a hard time returning it.

The serve is the most important stroke in tennis. The served ball must land in a boxed area on the opponent's side of the court. If the ball misses that box, it is called a fault. The server then gets another chance to serve. If the server makes another fault, the opponent gets a point. On the other hand, the server earns a point by serving the ball so well that the opponent cannot hit it. This is called an ace.

A player needs four points to win a game. Points are counted in four stages: 15 for the first point, 30 for the second, 40 for the third, and game. A score of zero is called love. The server's score is given first. For example, if the score is 30–love, the server has two points and the opponent none. If both players reach 40, the score is called deuce. The player who scores the first point after deuce must also get the next point to win the game. In other words, a player must win by two points.

A series of games makes up a set, and a series of sets makes up a match. The first player to win six games traditionally wins a set. But again, a player must win by two. This means that a player cannot win a set by a score of 6–5. The set continues until one player wins by two games—for example, 7–5 or 8–6. To win a match, a player usually has to win either two out of three or three out of five sets.

**On some Fridays I play tennis with my mum. Sometimes I win and she sometimes wins but we always have fun. We have even hit the ball right over the fence of the tennis court and I have seen James at the tennis court too.**

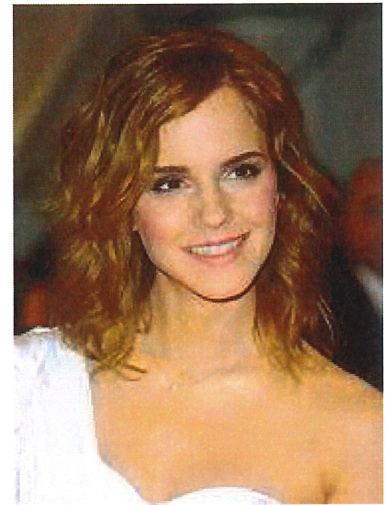

**Tip 3** - always have a backup plan! Sometimes a platform is so busy they won't let you off so always listen to the announcements on the tube.

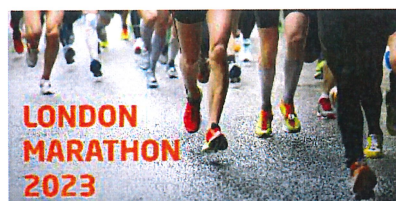

I first noticed that he had one arm and then that he had greyish black marks across his back. I asked him what they were. He replied that they were machine gun bullets.

### **Why do you like learning about WW1?**

Because it is more than just the military side. It is the way it changed Britain. Britain before WW1 was very different to Britain after. For example, transport evolved. Before it was carriages and horses but then buses and motorcars. Many others including medicine and technology.

### **How long have you been interested in WW1?**

Since about 1982. That is a long time about 40 years.

### **What is your favorite story in WW1?**

There are hundreds of stories of very brave people but there is one about a very brave and resilient person. A man who never stopped caring for those who need caring for. His decisions reflect many people's lives today. There was a doctor in France in September 1914. He was treating the men who were wounded in the trenches. He was treating a man, when a bomb fell, injuring him very seriously which resulted in him losing his leg. A normal person would just look after themselves but this man thought of others and did what was right. He treated that man.
