The girls ended up as worthy 3-1 winners with an amazing goal from half way by Phoebe. Fingers crossed we have done enough to progress to the knock out stages.






Despite feeling downhearted, they can still be very proud of their performance.

Iknoor was awarded a medal and trophy after participating in a recent football tournament!














