Class Based Worship

This week's Picture News worship was all about Manchester United's plans for a new stadium – plans to create a stadium that will seat over 100,000 people. Children discussed how stadiums can be used for many different purposes and that lots of people can use them – for example concerts and exhibitions. We also discussed that football stadiums can be used by men's and women's teams and that building a big stadium has positive and negative impacts on the local area. We considered that we have a responsibility to work and to look after our planet responsibly.

We looked at the Bible verse Genesis 2:15

The Lord God took the man and put him in the Garden of Eden to work it and take care of it.

Questions you can ask your child

- Have you ever visited a stadium? If so, what for and how did you feel?
- How might a stadium help bring people together?

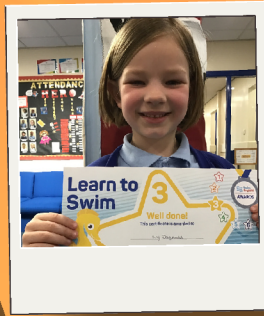
LIGHT SHINE!

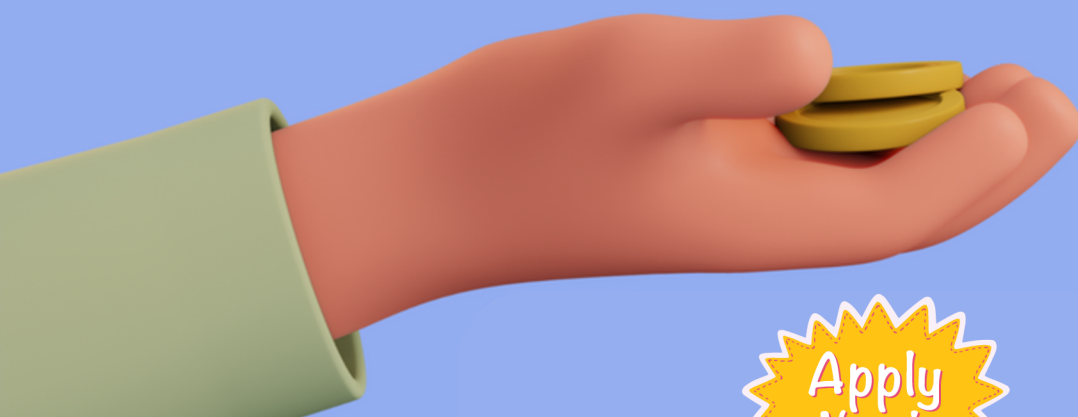
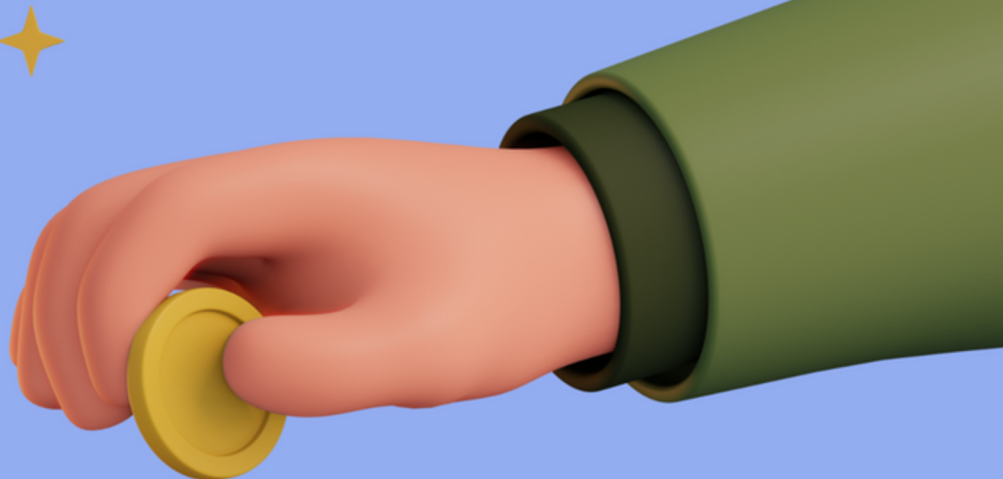

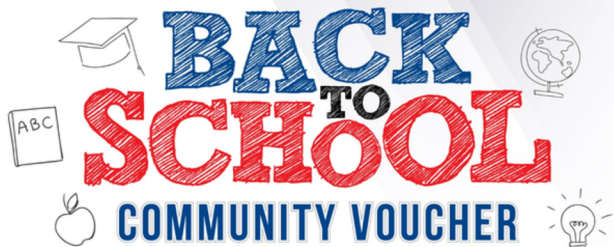
