## Catering Changes

From Monday 1st September, the cost of school meals for paying pupils in Key Stage 2 (Years 3 – 6) will be £2.90. School dinners are payable in advance via the School Gateway app.

Children in Reception, Years 1 and 2 are entitled to a free school lunch under the Universal Free School Meal Scheme.

Families with children in Key Stage 2 who are receiving any of the following benefits, may be also entitled to Free School Meals:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit - if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

## Our School Day

Cold-like symptoms followed by a rash a few days later. Some people also get small spots in their mouth.



- high temperature
- runny or blocked nose
- sneezing
- a cough
- red, sore, watery eyes.
- small white spots may appear inside the cheeks and on the back of the lips a few days later.
- raised rash on the face and behind the ears before spreading to the rest of the body a few days after the cold-like symptoms
