#### **CAKE DONATIONS**

Cake stalls are always popular and we would welcome donations of cakes from families.

To enable us to sell cakes, we need them provided in the original boxes or, if the cakes are home made, we need a full ingredients list.

This is required to ensure that we can provide information, if needed, for anyone with food allergies.

Thank you for any shop bought or home made cakes which you can donate. It is much appreciated. Shop bought cakes may be donated at any time before the Fair. Home made cakes may be brought into school on Friday 26th September.

#### **ENTERTAINMENT**

If you or your child is a talented singer and would like to entertain visitors to the Fair with a song or two, please let us know via the school office.

Our school choir will be performing to open the fair.

# SUPPORT FOR FAMILIES WITH PUPILS WITH ADDITIONAL NEEDS

A designated quiet space will be available for any pupils or adults with additional needs who require a quieter area to calm or relax for some time during the fair.

In addition, passes will be issued for pupils with additional needs so that stall holders and adults staffing stalls, games and activities are aware of the extra support needed.

#### **PLEA FOR GAZEBOS**

If any family has a gazebo that we can borrow for the Autumn Fair, please let the PTA know by informing the school office.

We would need the gazebos brought to school on Thursday 25th September, clearly marked with your family name so we have them for setting up the Autumn Fair on the following day.

#### PREPAID VOUCHERS

Rather than bringing cash, families may purchase prepaid vouchers which can be used at school stalls (not with external stallholders).

Prepaid vouchers can be purchased on School Spider or the School Office NOW!

#### **MATCH FUNDING**

Some businesses and employers offer match funding, where they will match the funds raised by a charitable organisation's fund raising efforts.

Our PTA is a registered charity so may be eligible for match funding. This means that if the Fair raises £500, this may be doubled to £1000 by match funding!

Please check with your employer if they offer a match funding scheme so that we may apply.

If successful, this would double the money raised during the fair.

Every penny raised is used to enrich opportunities for our pupils so having the fair income doubled, significantly increases what children can enjoy and benefit from.

Thank you for checking with your employer to see if this is something they can support.
