Message from Headteacher

We continue to support children following the passing of Queen Elizabeth II. This week, we have talked to children about the events that have taken place since her death and the arrangements for her funeral on Monday. As they always do, your children have shown such thoughtfulness in the light of recent events.

We talked about how King Charles has stepped up to do his duty in the days since his mother's death and how this is tricky in the midst of his own grief. Some Year 6 leaders have composed letters to King Charles to encourage him to do exactly what we promote at our school – to keep on going and work hard to do his best. We plan to post these letters to wish our new king well.

This half term, we are focusing on the value of compassion. We discussed how this means that you do not just feel sorry for someone, but you take positive action to try to help them. We made links to compassionate people the children know about who have taken action to help others: Sir Bob Geldof, Mother Theresa and Nelson Mandela. Over the last two weeks, I have so many incidents where children have shown compassion for others reported to me! Pupils are certainly being vigilant for others who need help and support.
